



The following three-week transition window was approved by the Texas Education Agency on October 21, 2020 and the Weslaco ISD School Board on October 22, 2020. This window gives parents the choice to have their child return to their campus should they meet the criteria as indicated below. Our School Board was limited to approving only what TEA has granted. The return to school is gradual as the health and safety of our students and staff is our priority.

This is not mandatory. Parents can choose to have their child remain at home for remote learning the entire 2020-2021 school year.

<p>Week 11 (Nov. 9 - 13)</p>	<p>Students who can return to campus are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Limited/no connectivity 5th, 6th, 12th grade students who are failing two or more core subjects 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 7th, 8th, & 9th grade students who are failing two or more core subjects 10th & 11th grade students who are failing two or more core subjects WISD staff children All 3rd, 4th, 5th grade students and their siblings, 6th, & 9th students <p>All teachers back on campus with limited students in attendance</p> <p><i>Other: High school hybrid schedule continues.</i></p>
